CONSTITUTION

ARTICLE 1

Name and Purpose

Section A – The name of the Association shall be the Butterfield Lake Cottage Owners Association, Inc. (BLCOA) and shall here after in this document be referred to as the Association.

Section B – The objectives of the Association shall be:

1. To promote high standards of care and conservation of Butterfield Lake and to inform Association members of matters pertaining there to.
2. To encourage the propagation, preservation and distribution of wild life, fish, bird sanctuaries and breeding grounds. To work for the conservation of marginal lands, swamps, and ponds. To protect and develop plant life in its native state. To encourage the preservation and purifications of springs and streams, and the prevention of erosion and contamination of the water shed of Butterfield Lake.
3. To encourage and support legislation which will accomplish the foregoing; to aid and cooperate with all public authorities in so doing and to affiliate or cooperate with other organizations having purposes similar to this Association.
4. To prepare and circulate literature and adopt any other method of informing all cottage owners of the need for such conservation work for the general health and welfare of Butterfield Lake.
5. To promote activities and/or programs that will develop relationships and friendships among the cottage owners to foster the well-being of the lake community.
